- I. **Call to Order at 6:04: Attending: Karri Couste, Darla & John Dodge, Linda Dosey, Julie Slocum, Wendy Yang, Linda Marantette, Kim Dawley & Deanna Fine**
- II. **Approval of Minutes from November 10, 2015.** Darla motioned to approve the minutes. Kim seconded the motion.
- III. **Treasurer's report:** November and December's Treasurer's report. Nov. ending balance is \$22,513.39. Dec. ending balance is \$22,497.47. Deanna motions to approve the Treasurer's report. John seconded the motion.
- IV. **Committee Report**
 - a. Registration: We have four early registrations so far. During the March meeting we will be putting the registration packets together.
 - b. Decorations: Hollywood theme. Karri will go to the storage unit. Ideas? Movie posters from Fandango, or Stadium Cinema Theaters. Records spray painted gold, street signs: Rodeo Dr., Hollywood Blvd., Hollywood sign, Star Wars. Red Carpet for pictures.
 - c. Food: Will analyze the list to modify it. Deanna will call Mike about drinks and snacks for the bus. If they can't do it, we'll contact Pepsi; we can also ask them about water. We needed more water. Two, or more, cases per bus. We need to look at the numbers as we get close. We will get a Chocolate fountain, and can possibly borrow a popcorn machine from CHS. Wendy Y. can check on this. There is one in the snack bar at the high school. Ice Cream Machine from Q's. We will need to buy the mix. Discussion about too many energy drinks led to the consideration of medical supplies needed for upset stomachs. Karri, Wendy, and I will meet in Feb. 23rd at Karri's to start organizing food.
 - d. Entertainment: Karri's mom will start looking into this.
 - e. Busses & Tickets: Preorder before March 31st cut-off date. We decided to get 200 tickets ahead of time, along with seven parking passes. Thank you Kim!

V. Old Business

a. 5k Walk/Run:

- Banners are made! We will use the small ones at Walmart when we sell raffle tickets. The large one will be put out in front of the school. Sign Pro donated everything. Next year the coordinator can take the signs back to Sign Pro to get the date changed for free.
- As of now we have 16 sponsors. The new ones are Quik Stop & Partnership Carson City. We are always looking for more sponsors. Each sponsor pays \$250.00. Their information goes on Facebook, the website, and two news articles. In addition, they get two race entry tickets.
- So far we have fourteen raffle prizes. Other prizes are still pending.
- Dan Kim volunteered to DJ.
- The Safe Driving group will be at the race to hand out flyers.
- This year we will use a hand held timer through a phone.
- T-shirts will come from Graphics Factory
- We will sell tickets at Walmart over the next few week-ends.
- We have a goal of selling 600 raffle tickets. Tickets are \$5.00 each or five tickets for \$20.00.
- Julie is working on getting volunteers ready for the 5K.
- Jan. 30th stuff bags at Susan Lani's
- Red's Pre-packet pick up will be Thurs. Feb. 4th from 5:00-8:00 pm.
- We still need runners.

b. Sports/Club decals: We will sell them at Walmart and the 5K. \$5.00 each. We're still looking in to having CHS club names on the decals. We will give a dollar cut to those who agree to have their names put on the decals.

c. Craft Fair: We earned \$950.00 total for volunteer hours, and \$121.00 from car decals.

VI. New Business

a. Sandwich boards: We purchased three sandwich boards to advertise at various events we go to. \$113.08 for all three. We have special pens that we can use which don't easily erase.

b. Timelines: Each of us should put together timelines so that we know who to contact and when. This way we will have a running record of how we organize Safe Grad for future committee members.

c. Meeting with Ms. Fuson: Karri met with Mrs. Fuson and she OK'd that Safe Grad will be the only one to sell decals. She also supported the 5K as a permanent fundraiser. They talked about doing some of the activities for safe teen driving; every 15 minutes, etc. We will plan on doing it for the class of 2017-2018. Karri will discuss this with Mrs. Fuson and Mr. Chamberlin further.

d. 5k contest: There will be a contest to see who can sell the most tickets. Dutch Bros. \$75.00 for 1st prize, and \$25.00 for the 2nd prize.
