- I. **Call to Order: 6:02pm**
- II. **Member in Attendance:** Kyra Hinton, Gina Winder, Karri Couste, Diana Zemp, Wendy Yang, Bobbi Yasmer, Linda Marantette, Julie Slocum, Kim Dawley
- III. **Approval of Minutes from the January 10, 2017 meeting:** Julie motioned to approve and Diane seconded. Approved
- IV. **Treasurer's report:** Beginning Balance as of 1/01/17 was \$31,744.84. 3 EFTs cleared Secretary of State Renewal \$100.00, Host Gator monthly charge \$8.99 and Harland Clark (check order) \$27.55. 2 checks cleared Carson City School District for facility use for 5K \$264.00, Bighorn Racing (deposit 5k timing) deposit for \$200.00. 3 pending checks The Flag Store (5K medals) for \$42.00, USPS (post office box) \$106.00 and IDNS (renew of carsonhighsafegrad.com website) \$45.00. The following deposits were made: Buffalo wild wings, sponsorships, R Willis registration for 5k and craft fair for \$1315.50 and Sponsorships for 5K \$500.00. Wendy motioned to approve and Linda seconded it. Approved. Kyra to check if the Host Gator is on a monthly renewal and whose card it is attached to. Monthly fee of \$45.00 due but Bobbi can't login into site; Kyra to check if it has to do with the website. PO Box was locked for being \$2.00 short but has been taken care of. Craft Fair brought in \$905.00; need to push for more volunteers next year. Bill of \$50.00 to Office Depot for 5K fliers Julie motioned and Diana seconded it. Approved
- V. **Old Business**
 - a. **5K update**-Total registered runners 68; down 36 due to weather. Registration brought in \$1315.00, sponsors \$3,600.00 and raffle tickets \$2,381.00 for a total of \$7,296.00. Still waiting on Kohl's and Red's sponsorship money and Race360.00 registration and raffle money to come in. Expense total \$1,657.41 went up from last year for district facility use fee's and timing fees. Total revenue for 5K \$5,638.59
 - b. **Decorations**-Gina to coordinate a meeting for decorations and committee to help. June 3rd at 8am is when decorations can go up at the community center. Kyra volunteered to help with decorations.

- c. **Entertainment** -Gina to head up entertainment and Karri will assist
- d. **Busses**-Kim reserved 5 buses \$11,525.90 up from last year. Deadline to order tickets at \$29.71 is March 15th 2017. Kim will speak with Cameron the ticket contact with Six Flags to see if we can keep the same price if we need to order more tickets. Kim to order 200 tickets for Six Flags, Diane motioned and Bobbi seconded it. Approved. Parking is \$20.00 up from \$17.00 from last year. Hotels have not been reserved or looked into yet. Sheila Story will be coordinating volunteers and will be in charge this year but will need a new chair committee for next year. Need to collect 2 cases of water per bus and single serve food items for bus. In need of chaperones- requires a background check and Kim has the forms.
- e. **Food**-Wendy in charge of food. Drop off at community center on Friday night June 2nd. In need of 3-4 helpers to call for food donations. Each food donation the helper coordinates will need to pick up food and drop off at the community center. Linda, Bobbi and Diana volunteered to help. Julie will coordinate volunteers and give names to Wendy for Wendy to schedule shifts.
- f. **Volunteers**- Julie is need of volunteers

VI. **New Business**

- a. Prom-Erin Bean suggested moving safe grad for Prom. Motion made to move; approved, unanimous vote to leave safe grad as a graduation celebration. Suggestion to Erin Bean if she would like to start a safe program for prom to contact Safe Grad Booster and they will help in getting her started with suggestions. Karri to respond to Erin Bean.
- b. PO Box- new form for updated information. Karri gave to Kyra to fill out and send in
- c. Raffle Prizes for Safe Grad Night- Budget for \$300.00. For donations need a really motivated person to contact businesses for donations. Gift cards are the easiest for seniors.
- d. Safe Grad Ticket Pricing- \$50.00- seniors can turn in their tickets at Six Flags for a discounted season pass.
- e. Kyra to become President next year. Suggestion that Kyra to attend all committee meetings.

VII. **Fundraisers**

- a. Chili Cares-Wendy provided flyers. Chilis will donate 20% March 14, 2017 of all proceeds from 11:00am-10:00pm but customers have to tell them they are there for Safe Grad. Wendy emailing Kyra flyer to add to website. Julie will be hanging flyers in the school. Kim will hang fliers at City Hall and next to Raley's.
